ABOUT GALAXY I



Launched in 1998 and extensively refitted in 2006, MY Galaxy I is a 26 metre luxury superyacht based in the stunningly beautiful area that is Tropical North Queensland. Sleek, sophisticated and superbly appointed, Galaxy I is designed for indulgence and will satisfy the most discerning traveller.

Permanently berthed in Port Douglas, Galaxy I is available for a maximum of 12 people for day charters to the Great Barrier Reef.

Alternatively, sleeping 6 passengers comfortably, Galaxy I is perfectly designed for extended multi day cruise itineraries aimed at exploring and experiencing one of the natural wonders of the world.

EMBRACING THE ENVIRONMENT



First impressions of Galaxy I are of lovely lines, polished timbers and chrome. Interior highlights are of rich textures and materials intended to accompany features that have been specifically designed to embrace the environment of the Tropical North.

All interior areas are air conditioned and the rear saloon deck can be enclosed for air conditioning as well. Flat screen televisions, DVD players with a full library and a surround sound stereo system ensure that creature comforts are never far away.

Dining aboard Galaxy I is an experience in itself. With two designated dining areas, and casual seating on both the forward and upper decks, Galaxy I is perfect for revelling in the climate that makes this area one of the most desirable to visit in all of Australia.

Galaxy I's on board chef takes full advantage of the abundance of local natural produce, whilst ensuring that every palate is catered to. Everything from formal dinners to casual BBQs can be offered for consideration.

ACCOMMODATION



Comfortably sleeping 6 passengers, the staterooms of Galaxy I continue the attention to detail seen throughout the entire vessel. The master stateroom boasts a king size bed, with marble ensuite. The stateroom also has it's own TV and DVD player and stereo system. Two guest staterooms feature twin bedding and own ensembles, again with their own TV and DVD player.

RELAXING AND EXPLORING



Galaxy I is designed around 3 spacious decks allowing guests to mingle as a group or to find their own space.

The upper deck of Galaxy I is perfect for relaxing on a sun lounge in the balmy climate of the Tropical North.

The forward deck is ideal as a sunset venue complete with canapés and pre dinner drinks, while the saloon deck is a perfect example of why alfresco dining is the preferred dining option in this area of Australia.

For those seeking a little adventure, then Galaxy I's wave runner will supply endless hours of fun.

The vessel also has a full range of snorkeling and fishing equipment as well as several paddle skis.

Galaxy I is also serviced by a 60hp tender to ensure access to all areas.

WHERE TWO WORLD HERITAGE AREAS MEET

Port Douglas provides direct access to the world's largest marine park – The Great Barrier Reef. Extending over 2300km from the tip of Cape York to the Central Queensland Coast, it is made up of 2900 individual reefs and 71 coral islands.

Looking from Galaxy I's decks towards land, nature's splendour is on display with the World Heritage listed rainforests of North Queensland, the oldest continuing rainforest on Earth.

Galaxy I can design an itinerary to combine both these areas that will be remembered long after the trip has ended.



Low Isles Itinerary (Full Day)

Depart:- 8:45am Return:- 4:30pm
Maximum Passengers:- 12

Journey to one of the jewels of the Great Barrier Reef, the enchanting coral cay island of Low Isles, just 1 hour from Port Douglas. Fringing coral reefs, sandy beaches and tropical rainforest combine to offer a very relaxing experience. Relax aboard Galaxy I as the crew serves lunch or take a leisurely stroll around Low Isles. No trip to the Great Barrier Reef is complete without seeing the kaleidoscope of colour below the water's surface and Galaxy's crew is on hand to ensure that this adventure will be one to savour.

Outer Reef Itinerary (Full Day)

Depart:- 8:15am Return:- 5:30pm
Maximum Passengers:- 12

Galaxy I's Outer Reef itinerary is an experience that will not be forgotten. Boarding early morning, Galaxy I cruises for approximately 2 hours to a specially selected location on the outer ribbon reefs. Typically the visibility is excellent, the marine life abundant and the coral amazing as you immerse yourself into this extraordinary natural wonder. Lunch is served by Galaxy I's onboard chef, and guests are encouraged to relax and utilize the spacious decks and enjoy all that Galaxy I has to offer.



Multi Day Itinerary from Port Douglas incorporating Cape Tribulation and the Great Barrier Reef

Day One (L,D)

Leaving Port Douglas, you will cruise to the mouth of the mighty Daintree River. You will be met by an experienced tour operator who will take passengers on a ½ day tour into the ancient rainforests of the Daintree. Arriving back on Galaxy I, sunset drinks are served as you relax at your sheltered overnight anchorage.

Day Two (B,L,D)

Awake to the gentle dawn light of North Queensland's sunrise. Breakfast is served alfresco on the saloon deck as Galaxy I begins cruising to the Outer Barrier Reef. The reef is yours to enjoy

as Galaxy I's experienced crew help you to encounter this wonderful natural spectacle. At the end of the day, drinks and canapés are served as you enjoy a sunset like no other before sitting down to dinner.

Day Three (B)

A leisurely breakfast, as Galaxy I begins the cruise home. The last stop on the journey is the spectacular coral cay of Low Isles. A final swim on the Great Barrier Reef, before the marina of Port Douglas beckons and Galaxy I berths mid afternoon.

Multi Day Itinerary from Port Douglas incorporating Cooktown and Lizard Island.

Day One (D)

The area north of Port Douglas is considered to be one of the last frontiers of Australia. Uninhabited coastlines, wild rivers and never ending rainforest paint a picture of harsh, but beautiful country. Leaving Galaxy I's home port, you will journey along this coast to your destination Cooktown, one of the most significant historical townships of Australia.

Day Two (B,L,D)

Upon awakening, a ½ day tour in Cooktown is organised for you. After lunch, Galaxy I cruises from Cooktown to the spectacular Lizard Island for overnight anchorage.

Day Three (B,L,D)

Lizard Island is frequented by only a few and it is yours to discover. Rising 359m above the coral sea, it is a stark contrast to the sparkling waters that

surround it. Walking trails, amazing snorkelling and fishing are just some of the activities you can look forward to. Galaxy I remains at Lizard Island for overnight anchorage.

Day Four (B,L,D)

After breakfast, Galaxy I cruises to the extraordinary ribbon reefs of the Great Barrier Reef. The day is spent relaxing either on board Galaxy I or enjoying the fascinating underwater world of the reef. After dinner, Galaxy I begins cruising for home.

Day Five (B,L)

Awake to the lovely vista of Low Isles, a stunningly beautiful coral cay sitting off the North Queensland coast. A final walk, a final swim, before Galaxy I returns to her home port.

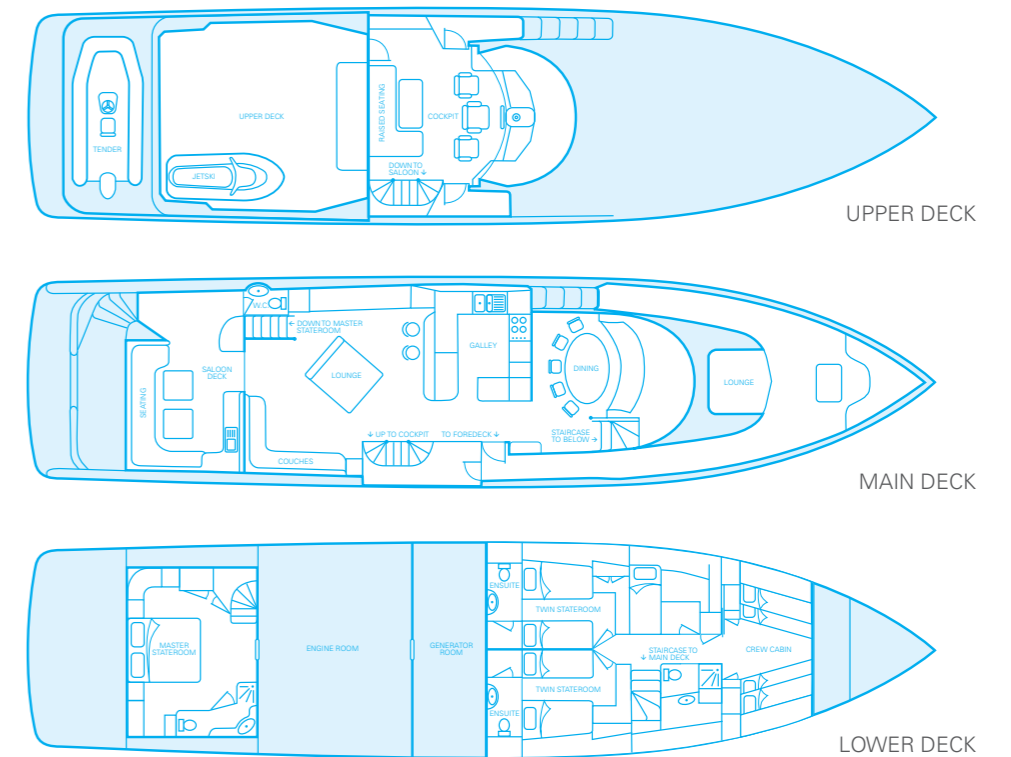


Captain Nick Atkinson
